Ladies and Gentlemen,

It is my pleasure to present for your consideration and adoption the Annual Report for season 1985.

This season could be classed as disappointing as far as the clubs on field activities went with all four senior and three junior teams entered in the Dandenong Baseball Association failing to make the finals.

Off the field two important changes took place. Following the resolution passed by members at the General Meeting in March the Committee applied for and were granted incorporation status. As was explained during the season this simply means that the club is an entity itself, somewhat like a company. The second important change was the issuing of a Restricted Club Permit which allows the club to legally sell alcohol. It also meant strict adherence to the rules laid down by the Liquor Control Commission and I would like to thank all members for their observance of these rules.

Both these measures, we believe, provide us with a more professional approach to the running of the club and, as you will see by the Treasurer's report, the amounts of money we are now dealing with call for strict guidelines to be followed.

We were fortunate, at the start of the season, to gain the services of Murray Holmes as club coach. His enthusiasm, determination and natural competitiveness was certainly an asset to the club and our thanks go to him for his efforts.

Before going on to detail each grade I would like to make the point that it seems to be the general opinion around the club that our main problem this season was the loss of players from last year. It is very difficult when four A grade and five A reserve plus a couple from both B and C grade are missing at the start of a season. This led to moving players around and, on a few occasions to forfeits by the C grade who had to sacrifice some of their players to fill B grade. This is an Association rule and not the fault nor the desire of the Club. Also we were hit with illness, holidays, and general problems which cause a player to miss a game or two.

Nevertheless, I felt the general spirit of the club was good and feel very confident that we can move into 1986 assured of greater success.

A. Grade.

As mentioned earlier this side lost four players from last season and started off the season badly. However, the attitude and enthusiasm of all players remained at a high level as was shown by some great performances especially against Bonbeach and Cheltenham. Unfortunately a Frankston trait continued again this season in that we beat all teams above us with the exception of Monash, whilst losing to all lower placed sides. Whether it is a problem of playing down to their level or taking things too easy, or both is unclear but I would like to see this problem rectified next season. If we had won just two of these games we would have been playing off in the finals.

Our thanks go to Murray for his work with the team and also to Damien Shanahan whose coaching contributions were greatly valued.

A. RESERVE.

If the A's lost some players then the A Reserve virtually lost a team. For almost the first half of the season only two players from last years Grand Final winners were playing. Probably the main problem with the A. Reserves was their inconsistency, with some great plays one week being followed by some great errors the next. There was also some problem with late arrivals and players not turning up. On the credit side training attendances were good and many players gained a lot from this season. There is a lot of talent in the A. Reserves and hopefully with a more disciplined approach next season we will see them once again on top.

This season the A. Reserves were coached by David Simpson and we extend our thanks to him for his efforts. Also special thanks to Leah Simpson who did a great job as team scorer.

B. GRADE.

Writing up a report on the B. Grade (or Drunks as they are affectionately nicknamed) is always a difficult task. I think it is best to keep it short and just report that a good time was had by all. However, I would like to say a special word of thanks to their scorer Barbara O'Brien, not only for scoring but also for having the most picturesque score book probably in the world.

C. grade had a year of ups and downs, starting off the season well then, unfortunately falling into a bit of a hole only to come good again at the end of the season. Note must be taken of the fact that due to the lack of senior players several positions were filled by juniors who did a great job. The club would like to thank them for their efforts in the C. grade team.

I am reliably informed that there are some talented players in this side and with the experienced gained this season and a more settled team next season a better result should be expected.
