COACHES:

After a twelve month break from coaching we were fortunate to again gain the services of Daryl Dicker as Club Coach with Andrew Jones taking on the job of B. Grade manager and Noel Winther once again at the helm of the D. Grade.

Overall the 1990 season was extremely successful with four of the five teams making the finals and three teams playing off in Grand Finals. Of the three teams, A, D, and Under 18's only one team, D. grade, managed to win a flag but the effort of just getting there by the other two was tremendous. D. grades win was certainly a case of a well deserved reward after so many seasons of "so near and yet so far".

FRANKSTON BASEBALL CLUB INC.A. GRADE.

A. grade had a particularly rocky season with probably their worst win/loss record for several years. Nevertheless they finished third after the home and away games and were firm favourites for the first semi against a much improved Dandenong side. After an initial shaky start the team steadied to come from behind and record a comfortable 10 - 5 win and a chance to play Cheltenham in the preliminary final. In what was arguably the best game of the final series Frankston once again had to come from behind and stave off a last innings rally by Cheltenham to win 7 - 6 and their second chance at the premiership flag in two years. Unlike the previous two matches Frankston jumped to an early lead scoring three runs in the first innings. Unfortunately only one other Frankston run was added and went down 7 - 4. Congratulations to all the players on their efforts throughout the season.

B. GRADE

B. Grade also had a an up and down season with 10 wins, 5 losses and 3 drawn games finishing up third going into the business end of the season. Fronting up to Ormond/Glenhuntly in the first semi they led all day. However Ormond rallied in the ninth and the seconds unfortunately failed to make up the necessary runs and were out of the 1990 competition 11 - 9.

The B. grade was coached this season for the first time by Andrew Jones who together with "rookie" scorer Karen Adlington did such a great job and we offer our thanks.

D. GRADE.

The 1990 season was a very successful one with many juniors making up the D. Grade numbers. In fact, there were only six senior players within the team. With a 14-3 win/loss records for the season we finished in second place after the home and away games were completed. The semi final was played against Ormond at their ground but this advantage did not help them and we came out comfortable winners 11 - 5. This win put them straight into the Grand Final which was played against Oakleigh at Dingley. An excellent pitching performance by Roger Henry (8 innings, 9 hits, 5 K's.) was backed up by strong batting from all players and good all round fielding. At the conclusion of the game Frankston had a 19 - 8 score line and the first D. Grade flag ever.

Congratulations to all players who contributed so well over the season especially to Noel Winther who led them to this well deserved victory. Also thanks to Michele who has been so much a part of the team and who deserved to share in their success.
