#### COACHES:

*Our Club Coach for the 1995 season was again Mark Anderton, with Russell Clarke looking after B Grade and Bill O'Brien and Geoff Court looking after C grade.*

*The 1995 season had its ups and downs. We finished with 1 senior and 1 junior team making it through to the finals. Unfortunately the seniors were unable to win a flag but the junior team did win our first premiership in U/12.*

### A GRADE - Mark Anderton

Being the club's 50th Anniversary the A Grade squad had high expectations for a successful season with a premiership in mind.

The season looked good with the recruitment of an additional young pitcher of Matty Allanson coming across from Dandenong, who would prove to be a very valuable asset to help share the work load carried by Floyd over the last couple of years.

We also recruited wisely with the re-vitalised Chris Love returning from the olds and bolds.

The season proved to be very competitive, probably the most competitive for some years with places for the finals not being secure for any teams right up to the last game of the season. The A Grade had to work hard this year and were by no means the dominant team over the rest of the field.

As in past years, we again reached the finals but probably saved our poorest performances for the last two games of the year, eventually bowing out in the first semi-final to the eventual premiers Berwick.

I would like to thank all the players, committee members and my family for once again putting up with me in the role of Manager and look forward to another (and more successful) year of baseball at the patch.

### B GRADE - Russell Clarke

It was unfortunate that in the club's 50th year the success that we achieved as a team was not reflected on the scoreboard.

The start of the season brought together a combination of young players and some more experienced ones, some of whom hadn't played for a few years. As a result it took a while for us to start playing well as a team but towards the end of the season it was easy to see the improvement and with a bit more depth in the pitching department, we could have one quite a few more games towards the end of the season.

With the return of most of these players, strengthening the pitching staff and the influx of Junior players willing to play Senior baseball, we should have a much more successful season in 1996, as well as providing depth for the A Grade team.

### C GRADE - Geoff Court

1995 was quite a successful season for C Grade. Whilst we did not do too well as far as premiership points were concerned, we did provide a team that offered "social" baseball to the club. In doing this, we had 30 different players during the season and all of them thoroughly enjoyed the relaxed nature of this team.

The team won 6 of the 16 matches played - a very good result for the variety of players and the skills they possessed. Perhaps the most surprising part was the team batting average of .355, with Greg Evans winning the individual average with a very impressive .475.

Mark Dunn was the most valuable player, being a consistent performer at third base, batting .453 and hitting 23 RBI's.

### JUNIOR REPORT

#### Under 18 - Peter Gloury

Of the 11 players in the side, 9 were first year U/18's and although only having 2 wins for the season, this young side performed remarkably well.

Although our win/loss ratio was disappointing, the Frankston side was by no means disgraced as most games were narrow losses in the competition considered one of the strongest for some years.

Full credit must go the few 'older' players notably Aaron Buttons and Mark Richards, who both worked well on the mound and with the bat.

However, the pleasing aspect of the season was the potential shown by the younger members, who contributed greatly in providing the teams competitive nature.

The experience gained will no doubt hold them in good stead for the coming season and the club is confident that season 96 will see this sides potential recognised with higher rewards.

#### Under 16 - Noel Winther

It was not a very good season for the U/16. They struggled for numbers most of the season but still managed to put in some good on field performances. Many thank go to all the parents and spectators who came along each week to encourage the players. Hopefully 1996 will be a better season.

#### Under 14 - Stephen Schneider
