*The season began with only five players listed before the 1st game. During that week, a frantic amount of phone calls from both coaches and players to try and rustle up a "bare nine team" for the opening game.*

*Game One Dingley (H) - Up until 8.45am, we still had only five players, and we were certain that it was going to be just a practice match. Thankfully, another 3 players joined our ranks before the start, and we were able to play. A commendable 8-3 loss for the opening game.*

I can only say that the encouragement and enthusiasm shown by all the team and their parents was something to see. Thanks to everyone who came along to help with marking diamonds, etc. I hope the players come back in 2002 and have another great year.*

#### T-Ball - Rob Davis

*After a few years in hiatus T-ball returned with a vengeance in 2001. Driven mad by Thomas who wanted to play, I leapt into action to organise the first T-ball activity in 4 years. Due to earlier commitments we probably started our advertising a little bit late, which meant that numbers were down on previous T-ball seasons. We still managed to attract 21 boys and girls and their parents down to the club early on Sunday mornings.*

*In early June we kicked off a 10 week season with 21 kids' aged between 4 and 8, who were in various stages to development and co-ordination. With some kids it was hard enough to even pick which was their natural throwing arm, with others it was a battle to get them to stop hitting the kid standing in front of them in the batting line with their glove.*

*The first couple of weeks were, at best, a trial of our patience and our voices and I know personally, that I swore off big Saturday nights many times during those early morning sessions. However, with persistence and dedication shown by my coaching associates - Chris Love and Murray Bowra - we slowly started to see some real progress with the kids. By about week five the kids had developed enough fundamentals for use to actually try a 'real' game and I will forever remember how excited the kids were when they got someone out at first base for the first time. What we were trying to teach them seemed to start getting through (no longer was there 10 kids chasing and jumping on the ball at short stop - including the first baseman - which meant that when someone did eventually pick the ball up there was no one to throw it to, it seemed that only about five kids chased the ball but at least the first sacker was in position!!) Hitting was improving all the time and the kids and parents in the batting line seemed to be less susceptible to a bat travelling like a Blackhawk helicopter after being released excitedly by a batter, relieved to have laid bat on ball.*

*By the end of the season the kids had improved markedly and were pleasing with us for a World Series type showdown. Whilst we had wanted to keep the T-ball non-competitive, the punters had their way and a best of three series began. Well interestingly enough the series results were Red Team 1 win, Black Team 1 win and the decider game was drawn - 'WOW how 'bout that!!'. The kids couldn't believe it (but someone did find a copy of Don Kings book in Chris Love's bag!!.)*

All in all a good introduction year for me and we have learnt some things for this year, which will hopefully improve numbers and then improve chances of us retaining some of the kids for becoming U/12 players and then continuing on through the Tomato ranks. A big THANKS to Murray Bowra and Chris Love for their invaluable assistance on Sunday mornings (also to Chris Love for doing the certificates). A big THANKS to Maree for making sure the coffee was hot, to Peter Gloury for opening up the clubrooms and helping with the line marking, etc. Thanks to the club for supporting the concept and if we can continue we can increase our presence in the community, which has to be good for the club.
